FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Fr. Kevin MacDonald, a Redemptorist priest, will be preaching our mission this Monday, through Thursday at 7:00pm. Please come and attend this very popular mission, it is entitled "Beginning Again". Special graces are always given to those who make the extra effort to attend the mission. The Tuesday night will include a penance service. The Thursday night is the only one with a Mass. Fr. Kevin is from Woburn, Massachusetts, about 10 miles north of Boston. He entered the Redemptorist missionary order after attending Boston College and playing 7 years of professional baseball with the Pittsburgh Pirates and overseas in Holland and Australia. He is a member of the Boston College Hall of Fame. He is currently assigned to the Redemptorist Community in New Smyrna Beach, Florida.

The men's ACTS retreat will begin next week. We would like to have someone praying for them every hour during the retreat. The sign-up poster is now near the baptismal font. Please sign up and spend an hour in prayer for them. It can be done in your home and you can do any kind of prayer you'd like.

We also have a sign-up sheet in the sacristy for lay ministers, altar servers, and readers for Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday. Please sign up. Good Friday will be at Queen this year.

A few weekends ago I introduced the Diocesan Centennial Capital Campaign: Building Our Future Together. There are 5 case elements for this \$42.5 million dollar diocesan campaign. See elsewhere in this bulletin for the pie chart. Our parish goal is \$440,000.00 for Sacred Heart and \$35,000.00 for Belaire Cove. 30% of monies collected up to goal come back to us and 50% after goal. For Sacred Heart we will use the money to renovate the church. We hope that will begin in April or May. It will include a new A/C Heater System, a new drop ceiling, new lighting and new paint. For Belaire Cove we will replace the cross on top of the steeple with a new metal one as the present one has deteriorated. I am glad to report that Sacred Heart Church is now at 57% of our goal. Belaire Cove is at 82% of their goal. I believe we will surpass our goals easily. Thanks to all who have already pledged! Please pray for the success of our campaign and consider making your own sacrificial gift. You will be contacted personally or through the mail for your pledge.
