**FROM THE PASTOR**

Dear Parishioners,

Today we hear in the gospel about the blind man who is healed by Jesus. We are walking this Lenten journey with all of the catechumens around the world and candidates who will be receiving sacraments of initiation at the Easter Vigil. We pray that their sight of faith in Jesus will be clarified more and more. There are about 150,000 catechumens and candidates just in the United States. We have 2 here in our parish so let us continue to pray for all of them.

We had a very successful Men's ACTS Retreat last week. 36 men from St. Joseph, Our Lady Queen of All Saints and Sacred Heart Churches made the retreat with an equal number of team members from St. Anthony Church in Eunice. They are missioning to us until we can form our own team. The theme was from the gospel of the Samaritan women telling Jesus, "Give me living water that I may never thirst again." The art work based on that passage was done by a Sacred Heart student, Olivia Hernandez. The theme song was "40 days" which was beautifully sung by the men at the return mass at 10:00am. Then everybody in church was invited to reception in the high school Commons area. Thanks to all who participated and put this retreat together! This one will go down in history as the first Men's ACTS Retreat in Ville Platte. Our first Women's ACTS Retreat is scheduled for September 28th -October 1st. Then another Men's Retreat is scheduled for November 30th – December 3rd and then another Women's Retreat February 15th – 18th. We are not accepting applications yet for these retreats. We will notify you when registration begins.

Our Diocesan Centennial Campaign is progressing nicely. You should have received your pledge card if you did not then you are not registered here or we do not have your current address. Please contact us about that. We will have a special parish reception for all interested with questions about the Capital Campaign in the Meeting Room on Sunday, March 26th after the 10:00am Mass. There are 5 case elements for this \$42.5 million dollar Diocesan Campaign. Our parish goal is \$440,000.00 for Sacred Heart and \$35,000.00 for Belaire Cove. 30% of monies collected up to goal come back to us and 50% after goal. I'm glad to report that Sacred Heart Church is now at 70% and Belaire Cove is at 82.1%.

Knights of Columbus are having their annual BBQ on Palm Sunday, April 9th with pick up at the KC Hall. It is BBQ pork or ½ chicken with trimmings for \$8.00 per plate. If any high school students want to get service hours, cooking begins at 6:00am -10:00am and serving is from 10:00am -12:00noon. Make sure to make your Mass on Saturday evening or Sunday evening. On Tuesday at 6:00pm we will have a Church artwork tour here at Sacred Heart. All are invited!

Please pray for our men who will be on retreat in Grand Coteau March 30th – April 2nd.

It was mentioned during our mission that you can receive Holy Communion twice in one day. There is a stipulation that the one of the Masses must be a special Mass such as a wedding, funeral or etc. So you would not receive Communion twice a day for the same type of Mass.

Father Herb Bennerfield, pastor of St. Joseph Parish in Patterson, is leading a Centennial pilgrimage to Fatima Fatima in October 2017. The itinerary includes Toulouse (visit to the grave of St. Thomas Aquinas) Lourdes, Our lady of the Pillar Shrine in Zaragoza, Valley of the Fallen and El Escorial near Madrid Avila, and Santiago de Compostela in addition to Fatima. Highlighted feature of the pilgrimage: we will be in Fatima on October 13, the 100th anniversary of the miracle of the spinning sun. ## Catholic Outreach and Services

Several parishes throughout the Diocese have parish-based social service centers that serve the poor, hungry, and disadvantaged just as Jesus commanded. From Jeanerette to Mamou, Crowley to Breaux Bridge, soup kitchens, counseling services, and healthcare programs are all housed, supplied, and staffed by caring parishioners and community volunteers.

- Through the **Centennial Campaign: *Building Our Future Together***, the **Matthew 25 Endowment for Service to the Poor** will be established to be a perpetual source of funding assistance.
- \$1 million will be allocated to assist the flood victims.
- A designated portion of the funds will be granted to *Catholic Services of Acadiana* to subsidize the purchase and renovation of the New Life Center's new home.
- Designated monies through the **Centennial Campaign** will subsidize a much-needed facility improvement at the *Deaf Action Center*. The DAC's mission is to promote the independence of the deaf, deaf-blind, and the hearing impaired in South Louisiana.
