Sacred Heart School proudly announces the annual Catholic Schools Week celebration, which will run from Jan. 26 to Feb. 1, 2014. The theme this year is "Communities of Faith, Knowledge, and Service."

The theme encompasses several concepts that are at the heart of Catholic education. First, schools are communities – small families in their own right; but they are also members of the larger community of home, church, city, and nation. Faith, knowledge, and service are three measures by which any Catholic school can and should be judged.

The logo emphasizes a cross, which is at the center of all Catholic education. A swirl of vibrant colors around the cross, and the movement and shadows in the logo, portray the inner-connectivity and community life that are present in Catholic schools.

There are specially-designed activities that Sacred Heart will use to engage our students in celebrating the theme. Each classroom will construct a "virtual pilgrimage" site as part of the Faith component. The students will research different pilgrimage sites from around the world (for example, Jerusalem, Rome, Lourdes, Fatima, etc.). They will create a presentation and artifacts for display in their classroom; and they will invite the other classes, faculty, and parents to make a "virtual pilgrimage" to their classroom. In order to demonstrate their knowledge of the Faith, students will be quizzed on different aspects of the Faith. Every day, a religion question will be asked over the intercom. Each student who correctly answers the question will earn a chance to receive a prize. One prize will be given out per grade.

In addition, the students will compete in a friendly Catholic Quiz Bowl competition at the end of the week. The different grade levels will be divided up to compete against each other.

In order to promote Christian service to the poor, the Sacred Heart student body will help raise money for the Kobonal Haitian Mission. On Wednesday, after the celebration of Holy Mass, Alexis Darbonne (a representative of Cross Catholic Outreach, which works with Fr. Glenn Meaux's mission) will address the students about the great need in Haiti. At that moment, the Hearts for Haiti fundraiser will kick off, with the goal of raising enough money to be able to buy a house.

Although the celebration only lasts a week, it is a public display of a commitment to a solid Christian education that occurs every day at Sacred Heart School. Everyone is invited to visit Sacred Heart School during Catholic Schools Week to find out first-hand how students are raised to love the Lord, instruct their minds, and grow in virtue.

That Man is You! is a 26 week interactive men's program combining the best research from science with the teachings of the Catholic faith and the wisdom of the saints to develop the vision of a man fully alive. By honestly addressing the pressures and temptations that men face in our modern culture, the nationwide program called That Man is You! seeks to form men who will be capable of transforming homes and society.

In a joint effort between the men of Our Lady Queen of All Saints and Sacred Heart Church Parishes, the Fall Sessions of That Man Is You! was started in Ville Platte in early September of last year and was a huge success. The group had an average of well over 50 men attend each of the 13 Fall sessions. The 13 Spring Sessions will begin in early February and will include the bonus of a Lenten Journey during the weeks of Lent leading up to Good Friday and Easter.
