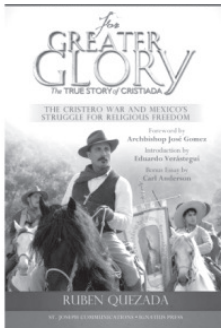


**Theresians “Lenten Day of Reflection”**
