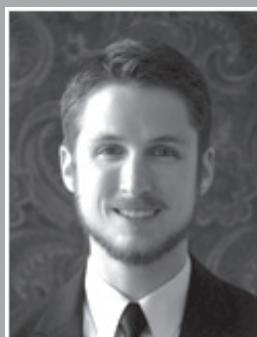

Therefore, we have decided to switch to a new candle company. As a result of the change, there are two adjustments that have to be made:

- 2- Neither the new candle company nor the distributor will recycle the candles, so, unlike the previous candles, you should dispose of them on your own.
