Friday June 7th, is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

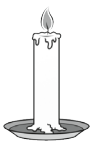
This is our Patronal Feast Day. We will celebrate a Solemn Mass that evening at

My dear People:

We have now reached the midway mark in the Year of Faith. Inaugurated by Pope Emeritus Benedict on October 11, 2012, the year ends on November 24, Feast of Christ the King.

In observing a year of faith the Holy Father invited us to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the beginning of the Second Vatican Council. It was a Council which proposed a strengthening of the Catholic faith in all the members of the church: Bishops, priests, and lay faithful. In the Year of Faith that strengthening is known as Evangelization.

In the midpoint of that Year I recall for your reflection that evangelization is threefold: "old" evangelization, on-going evangelization and NEW Evangelization. I suggest you think of this threefold evangelization in terms of church pews:

- The "old" evangelization, the first evangelization, began at Pentecost. It addresses those who have never had the gift of faith, those who have not ever been in the pews.
- On-going evangelization addresses those who are believers, practicing Catholics, those in the pews today.
- The New Evangelization reaches out to those who no longer practice their Catholic Faith, those who are no longer in the pews.

The old evangelization is found in the missionary activity of the Church. During this Year of Faith all should be promoting and strengthening that most vital missionary activity. I have encouraged pastors to host a mission appeal every year. Some do more than the minimum. We can hardly support the missions too much.

On-going evangelization is what you experience in your Parish: all of its activities, such as Mass, studies, prayer. They are meant to strengthen the faith of those who have remained in the pews and to bring us all into a deeper personal relationship with our Lord.

But very special to this Year of Faith are those who have left the pews. Their number is unknown but it certainly is large. All of us should ardently desire that our Catholic brothers and sisters return to the Church and rejoin us in the full practice of our precious Catholic Faith. And to this purpose I encourage all to reach out fraternally and lovingly to these fellow believers. Personal invitation continues to be in most effective means of return to Mass.

Our celebration of the Year of Faith will include a visit from His Eminence, Cardinal Daniel DiNardo, Archbishop of Galveston-Houston. Tickets are being allocated for each parish in the Diocese for the attendance at Vespers (Evening Prayer) on Wednesday, September 11, 2013, at 6:30 p.m. in the Cajundome Convention Center in Lafayette. Vespers will be followed by an address by Cardinal DiNardo and a reception.

The Year of Faith is half over. I encourage you to renew your observance of it. Intensify your prayers and efforts to strengthen the Faith. Be a vibrant part of the old, of the on-going and of the New Evangelization.

Spread the Faith by word and example.
