Dear parishioners,

Today we conclude our 5 week series of John chapter 6. Some of the disciples stop following Jesus because he told them that they must eat his body and drink his blood. Jesus then said to the twelve, “Do you also want to leave?” Peter responds that Jesus has the words of eternal life, to whom could they go? Peter basically was saying that he did not understand how he could eat Jesus’ body and drink his blood but that they had come to trust him and would not leave him. This is the great gift that Jesus has given to us in the Holy Eucharist. We are privileged to receive Him every Sunday and even every day if we wish. Let us not leave him like those disciples who did not trust in him.

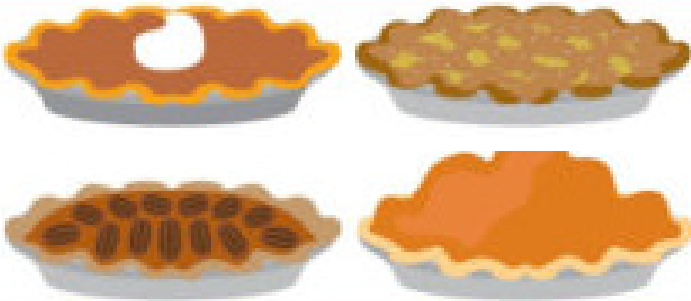
