PARISHIONERS FOR LIFE: MOTIVATING MEMBERS TO HELP END ABORTION

September 12th- National Day of Remembrance for Aborted Children

On **Saturday, September 12**, citizens for a Pro-Life Society, Priests for Life, and the Pro-Life Action League will co-sponsor the third annual **National Day of Remembrance for Aborted Children**, calling on pro-life Americans to honor the grave sites of our aborted brothers and sisters. Solemn prayer vigils will be conducted at these gravesites, of which there are 47 across the United States, as well as at dozens of other sites dedicated in memory of aborted children. Volunteers are still needed to host prayer vigils.

From our bishops:

“Things have gone too far...”

“In the United States abortion is legal throughout pregnancy. Yet abortion is a violation of human rights incomparable in magnitude and an atrocity for the whole human family. While *Roe v. Wade* appeared to create a right with some limitations, *Doe v. Bolton*, which was decided the same day, erased those limitations by creating a “health” exception so broad that it effectively allows abortion for any reason at any time... Most Americans are surprised and shocked to learn about the lack of any meaningful legal limitations for abortion. Most know things have gone too far. Together with those from many other faith communities, we work to bring about a society that recognizes abortion for what it truly is” (A Matter of the Heart -- A Statement of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops on the Thirtieth Anniversary of *Roe v. Wade*)

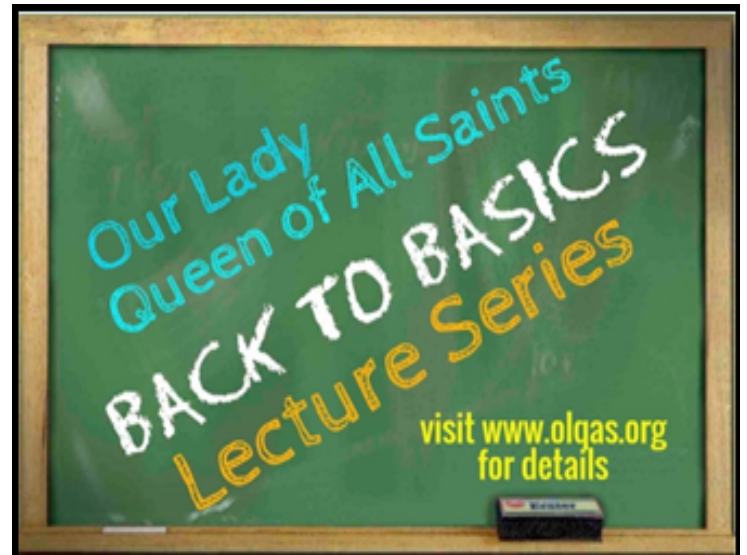
