FROM THE PASTOR

Dear parishioners,

We have come to the central passage of the gospel of Mark which is chapter 8. Here Jesus poses the big question to the apostles, "But who do you say I am?" Peter responds, "You are the Christ." This is the culmination of all Hebrew history as they were waiting for the coming of the Messiah which in Greek is Christ. Jesus immediately shares with them that even though he is the Christ he must suffer and die. Peter tries to stop him, but Jesus says that this is the way it must be and that we too must suffer with him.

Pope Francis is the successor of St. Peter. He is the chief shepherd and the guardian of the Church. Last Tuesday, Pope Francis simplified the annulment process by cutting out the second instance procedure so that will cut off about two or three months from every case. He also gave Bishops the power to judge certain cases himself. This is an example of the Pope using his authority throughout the universal church which he has the power to do. Pope Francis has been trying to do everything to help couples in these difficult circumstances. This does not change the indissolubility of the sacrament of matrimony.

We also hear an important passage from St. James chapter 2, versus 14-18 where he says faith without works is lifeless. This totally contradicts the faith alone assertion. We must prove our faith by works of charity. We can certainly agree on grace alone. It's all the grace of God.

Last week we mentioned the new 3 day candles which will be at the altars of Mary and Joseph. The 7 day candles will still be available for purchase but only to bring home.

I don't know if you've seen the videos exposing Planned Parenthood's trafficking in baby parts, sometimes even live babies. It shows the total deceit of Planned Parenthood which is all about making money at the expense of babies' lives and women's pain and suffering post abortion. From the Catechism

C2270 Human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception. 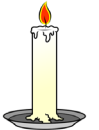

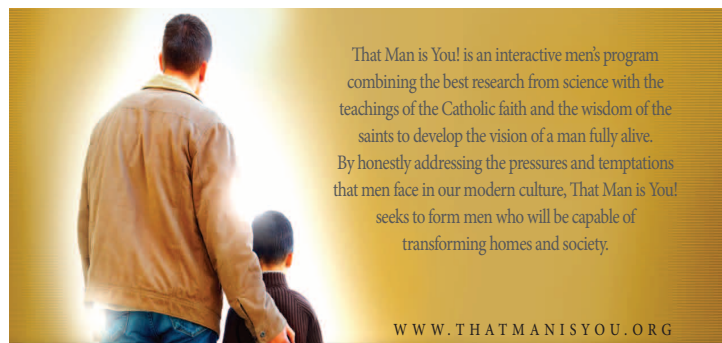
