Mes chers amis,

This month of October is traditionally observed by faithful Catholics as the Month of the Holy Rosary, with the liturgical memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7. This month is meant to inspire us to rediscover this traditional prayer, so simple yet so profound.

As Pope St. John Paul II often reminded us, the Holy Rosary is a powerful way of contemplating the face of Christ...of seeing Him with the eyes of Mary. At its core, the Rosary is based on the Gospel scenes of the life of Christ. Throughout the Church's history, it has been a fundamental way of getting to know Jesus and a great source of personal conversion. The Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary has been a source of comfort for those in sorrow or fear as well as a powerful weapon in the face of dangers and evil threats.
