



From November 1 through November 8, the Octave of All Saints' Day, the Church makes available some very powerful indulgences applicable only to the poor souls in purgatory.

On any and on each day during this week, we may obtain a plenary indulgence for the souls in purgatory by visiting a cemetery and praying, even only mentally, for the departed. Of course, we who obtain this indulgence for the departed must attend Mass that day and receive Holy Communion, go to confession within the week, and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (at least one Our Father and one Hail Mary).

On November 2, All Souls' Day, a plenary indulgence for the souls in purgatory may be gained by devoutly visiting a church and reciting an Our Father and the Creed.

To facilitate our praying for the deceased on these important days of grace, we priests and deacons of Ville Platte will accompany the faithful on the weekend of November 3-4 in our annual visits ("blessings") to the cemeteries. The schedule of these visits is found elsewhere in the bulletin.

Though we visit the cemeteries formally and officially on the weekend following All Saints' Day, please remember that you can visit the cemeteries every day from November 1 through November 8 and obtain the same plenary indulgence each day for the faithful departed.

I encourage you to fulfill this pious duty of faith by praying for the repose of the dead and by obtaining on their behalf and in their favor the holy indulgences made available by the Church.
