Dear Parishioners,

Upon receiving our new hymnals with Sunday Mass readings, I thought it would now be opportune to inform you about other options for those who would like to have their own missals to help them in praying and following the holy Mass. There are two main options available in the market today: subscription services and hand missals.

The subscription services are magazine-like publications that contain devotions, prayers, reflections, catechetical lessons, and the like, along with Mass texts and readings. Those available are:

1. The Word Among Us (with daily Mass readings). Found on-line at wau.org.
2. Magnificat. Found on-line at www.magnificat.net.

The book-type hand missals are available from three publishers:

1. St Joseph Missal
This missal is available in three volumes which can be purchased separately, one for Sunday Masses, and two for weekday Masses. Probably the most economical choice and the easiest to hold.

2. The St Paul Daily Missal – from Pauline Press
3. The Daily Roman Missal – from Midwest Theological Forum/Scepter Publishers

These last two missals contain all readings and Mass texts for daily and Sunday Masses in one volume. Both are handsome books, available in a variety of covers.

The hand missals can be ordered and purchased locally at Susan's on Court.

Whether you choose the subscription services or the hand missals, they all make very nice Christmas gifts.
