

Dear Parishioners,
I write you today to remind you of the importance of the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.

When you or a loved one becomes seriously ill or must undergo a serious, it is always good to prepare by making a good confession and receiving the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.

Moreover, it is important to do this in a timely manner, for if we wait too long and the situation becomes dire, it can easily happen that we priests are simply not available at that moment, due to our many ministerial commitments, with the result that a Catholic might not be able to receive the saving graces conferred in the sacraments of confession and anointing.

Please, then, take the time to call upon us priests *before* the situation becomes immediate and critical, upon first entering the hospital, so that you or your loved ones may be assured of ministry of grace in serious illness.

Sadly, once a person dies, the sacraments cannot be administered, and we priests can only come and offer prayers for the departed (which is itself no little thing). But how much better and salutary that one should be able to receive, while conscious and able, the sacraments of mercy and healing!

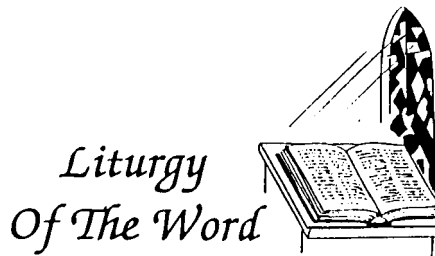
