TENEBRAE AT ST. JOHN'S CATHEDRAL, LAFAYETTE
The Cathedral Choir under the director of Mr. Thomas Niel will sing the office of Tenebrae on Palm Sunday evening, March 24, 2013, at 7:30 p.m. Tenebrae is an ancient monastic office normally sung during the Triduum. It includes the singing of psalms and antiphons in Gregorian Chant, as well as other sacred choral pieces with reference to the Passion of Our Lord. A highlight of the service is singing the Lamentations of Jeremiah set to an unusual, poignant, and ancient tone. All music is sung without accompaniment or "a cappella." The service is open to the public and offers a wonderful opportunity for prayer and contemplation in this most holy season of Lent. The Cathedral is located at 914 St. John Street, Lafayette, Louisiana.
